CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT

The YMCA believes building character is as important as building bodies, and the basis for Character Development includes: CARING, HONESTY, RESPECT, RESPONSIBILITY and FAITH. While families are the key to character development, parents and other caring adults have a primary responsibility to model values. The YMCA focuses on the development of the spirit, mind, and body of each individual, and plays a key role in character development through our programs and activities. We are committed to a positive approach to improving our community. Challenging people to accept and demonstrate positive values is as effective as treating problems. When you enroll in one of the many great programs the Great Miami Valley YMCA has to offer, you will see an emphasis on building character and developing these five important values.

FACILITY RENTALS

YMCA facilities may be reserved for special occasions (birthday parties, meetings, or other events). Reservations should be made at your branch. Please review other available materials that explain the various facilities, activities, and program offerings at our other locations.

LOCKERS/SECURITY

Lockers are available for daily use during your visit to the YMCA. We strongly advise the use of locks to protect your personal items, as the YMCA is not responsible or liable for articles damaged, lost, or stolen. Always lock your vehicle. Do not leave valuables in your vehicle.

Please use your own lock to secure your clothes and valuables in our "day use" lockers while you are working out at the YMCA. Locks left on overnight may be removed to allow use by other members. Locker rental service is available at an additional charge at most branches.

Youth ages six and older must utilize the family locker room or use the locker room of the same sex.

TOWELS

Members should bring their own towel. Towel service is available for a small fee at Hamilton Central and downtown Middletown only.

HOURS OF OPERATION/HOLIDAYS

The hours of operation vary from branch to branch and may change without prior notice. Always check with your YMCA for details. We make every effort to give advance notice when we must change our hours of operation.

SNOW DAYS

All facilities will close for a Level 3 Emergency. The YMCA building will remain open and operate, as near as possible to normal operating hours during any other



inclement weather condition. However, it may be necessary to cancel or postpone some or all scheduled classes. Any change in schedule will be announced on the Member Hot Button area of our website; on local radio and television stations, or you may telephone the YMCA for updated information. The exception to the rule would be our preschool program, which follows the corresponding city school's announcement of cancellations.

ACCIDENTS

Contact a YMCA staff person immediately if there is an accident, injury, or unusual incident. We are here to assist you. However, please be advised that you are participating in all activities at your own risk and are fully responsible for yourself, your children, and your guests.

MEDICAL CHECKUP

A pre-participation medical checkup and an annual medical evaluation by your physician, although not required, is strongly recommended for participation in YMCA physical fitness activities.

FOOD & BEVERAGES

Food and beverage services are provided for sale to members and are restricted to the lobby, vending area, or multi-purpose rooms. Absolutely no food, drinks, or gum are allowed in the wellness center, gym, gymnastics center, courts, pool areas, and locker rooms. We appreciate your help in keeping your YMCA safe and clean.

ATTIRE

When using the YMCA facilities, appropriate attire is required. Clean gym clothes and athletic shoes must be worn during all activities. **NO SHOES WITH BLACK SOLES THAT LEAVE MARKS ALLOWED ON THE COURTS, IN THE GYM, OR IN THE AEROBIC STUDIO.** In addition, appropriate swimsuits are required in the swimming pool. Cut-offs and gym clothes are not permitted in the pool. No shoes with cleats, roller blades or heeies are permitted in the building. For racquetball play, it is strongly recommended that "eye guards" be worn.

LOST AND FOUND

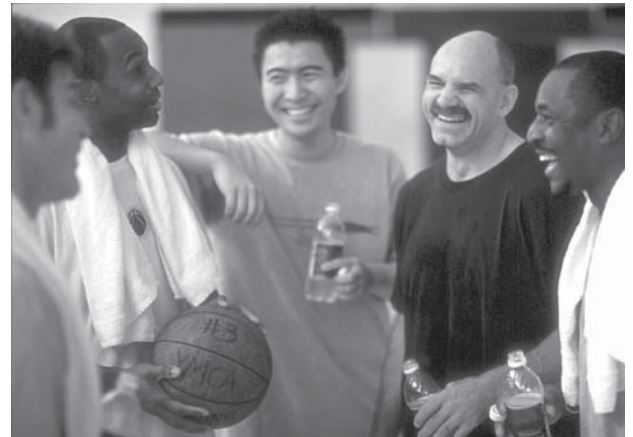
The YMCA is not responsible for lost or stolen property. However, we do keep lost and found items whenever possible. Please check at your YMCA for the location of the lost and found. Unclaimed items will be given to charity.

TOBACCO, ALCOHOL, DRUG USE

YMCA facilities and grounds are smoke-free environments. Alcohol and/or drug use will not be tolerated on YMCA property.

USE OF CELL PHONES, PHOTO CELL PHONES AND CAMERAS

Use of cell phones will be restricted to use in the lobby area only. Photo cell phones and cameras of any type are prohibited



in the YMCA due to the difficulty of distinguishing cell phones from photo cell phones and the possibility of abuse. Family members wishing to take pictures of their family members must apply for a Photo Pass from the Director on Duty at each branch where the photos will be taken. Photo identification, signature on a registration form, and written documentation of the relationship to the event to be photographed will be required. The Director on Duty may refuse to issue a Photo Pass in his/her judgment. Any person who receives a Photo Pass must display it when using any type of camera device. Persons taking pictures or videos without the Photo Pass will be asked to leave the premises.

YMCA Membership Benefits

Y CARE FUND- MEMBERSHIP FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE POLICY

It is the policy of the Great Miami Valley YMCA to provide services to all individuals who need them, regardless of ability to pay, within available resources. The YMCA has established fees at rates affordable to



the majority of residents in Butler County and Warren County. Those individuals unable to pay a fee may be awarded partial assistance based on their financial situation and the YMCA's ability to provide assistance. Assistance is available for both membership and program services. Financial assistance funds are made available due to the generous contributions to our Y CARE FUND. All records are kept confidential.

REFER-A-FRIEND INCENTIVE

Refer-a-friend to join the Great Miami Valley YMCA. When they join as a full member, YOU will receive a FREE month of membership. There is no limit to how many friends you can refer, so start saving today.

CINCINNATI UPGRADE

As a member of the Great Miami Valley YMCA, you can join the YMCA of Greater Cincinnati for an additional minimal charge each month. Visit one of the many locations of the YMCA of Greater Cincinnati to get started.

CHILD WATCH

The YMCA is happy to provide drop-in care for children, age 6 weeks to 9 years, while parents or legal guardians only, are in the facility enjoying programs at the YMCA. We provide a safe, fun environment for your children for up to 2-1/2 hours per day. There is no charge for full members. Please check your local branch for days and times. Sick children should not attend child watch.

WELLNESS CENTER EVALUATIONS

A fitness evaluation measures overall physical fitness by determining body fat, cardiovascular endurance, muscular endurance, strength and flexibility.

FITLINXX/FITNESS EQUIPMENT ORIENTATION

After completing and approval of the Health History Form, members receive a complimentary orientation to the FitLinxx computer system. This system allows the user to:

- Receive instant, objective feedback and coaching
- Communicate with the instructor through messaging
- Review progress and monitor results on every workout
- Review and enter workout information online from the comfort of your own home at fitlinxx.com

FITSTART (Free for full members)

This 12-week program follows the YMCA national personal fitness program for those individuals that:

- Have little or no experience with exercise
- Haven't exercised in a long time and need assistance getting back on track

- Need help incorporating fitness as a permanent part of their life
- Need personal attention and motivation.

MEMBERSHIP DUES

Your membership dues can be paid in one of three ways:

Monthly Automatic Debit

Under the Automatic Debit monthly payment plan, you can make a prorate payment to cover the payment until your first draft begins. You authorize the YMCA and your bank to automatically withdraw your monthly dues from your checking or savings account. If you prefer, your credit card can be billed each month. Your monthly dues continue as long as you are a member. You may discontinue your monthly draft by giving the YMCA 30-days written notice.

** There is a \$25.00 fee for returned bank drafts.*

Annual Payment

Annual payments may be paid by using cash, credit card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover), or by check.

** There is a \$25.00 charge for returned checks.*



Corporate Membership - Payroll Deduction

The YMCA is very proud of the many companies who invest in the good health of their employees through endorsing and supporting the YMCA Corporate Membership Program. Please contact our Metropolitan Membership Office at 737-9622 if your company is interested in offering payroll deduction to its employees for YMCA membership.

Payments can be made through payroll deduction for those companies who participate in the Corporation Membership Program.

FULL MEMBERSHIP

Full Members have complete access to all of the Great Miami Valley YMCA facility branches including fitness centers, gymnasiums, pools, racquetball courts, whirlpool, sauna and steam room. Full membership also includes free group exercise classes, water fitness classes and Child Watch (babysitting), and has reduced rates and priority registration on all programs.

Family/Household

Two adults living in the same household including their dependent children (up to the age of 18 or full-time student up to the age of 23. Proof of common permanent address is required at time of sign up.)

Family/Household Plus

Three or more adults living in the same household including their dependent children. (Up to the age of 18 or full time student up to the age of 23. Proof of common permanent address is required at time of sign up).

Single-Parent Family

Available for families with one parent living in the home (must be consistent with tax return).

Individual

Available for all persons 10 and up.

Health Center

Available to full members 21 years of age. Health Centers are available at the Hamilton Central Branch and the Middletown Area Family branches only. The Health Center facility includes workout area, locker facilities, towel service, laundry service, steam, sauna, and whirlpool. Health Center memberships are not available for sponsored memberships.

Family/Household Health Center

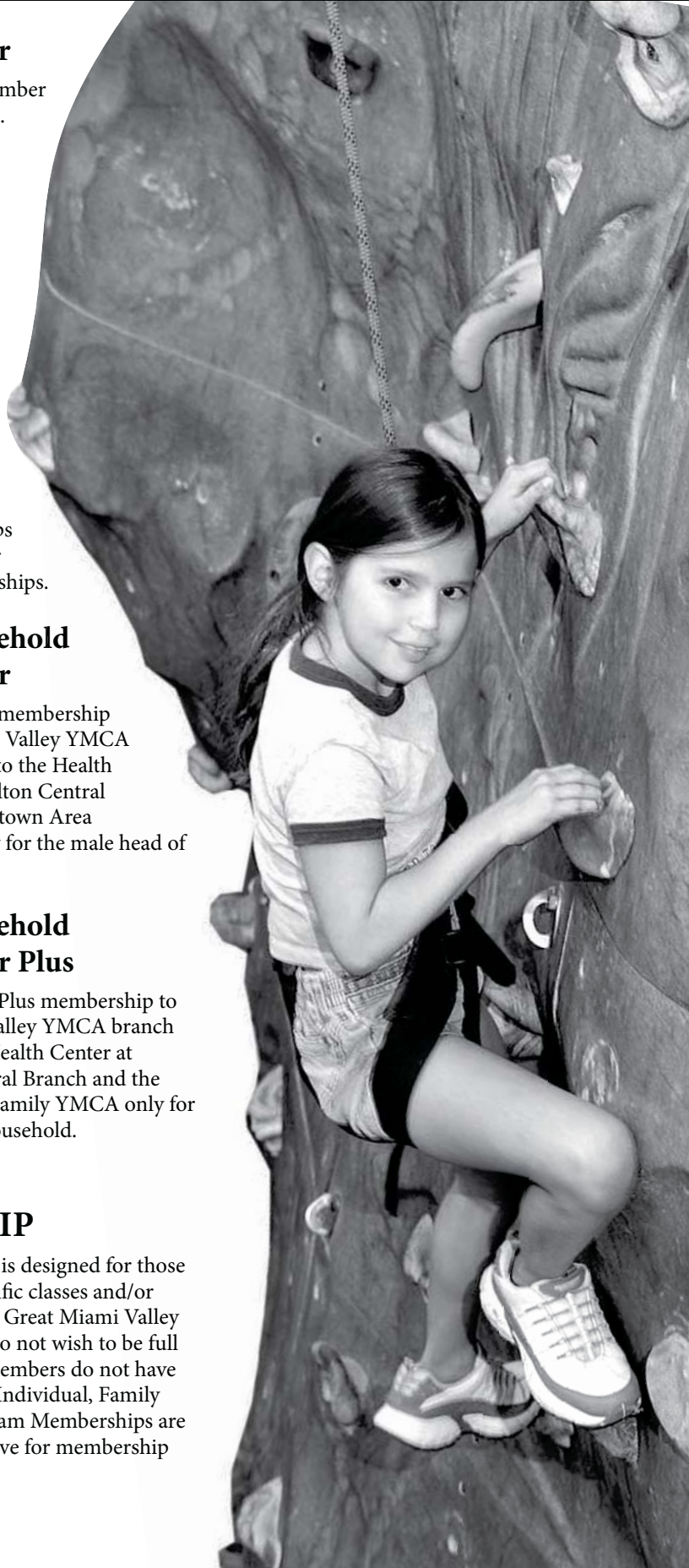
Family/Household membership to any Great Miami Valley YMCA branch plus access to the Health Center at the Hamilton Central Branch and Middletown Area Family Branch only for the male head of household.

Family/Household Health Center Plus

Family/Household Plus membership to any Great Miami Valley YMCA branch plus access to the Health Center at the Hamilton Central Branch and the Middletown Area Family YMCA only for the male head of household.

PROGRAM MEMBERSHIP

Program Membership is designed for those who want to take specific classes and/or programs at any of the Great Miami Valley YMCA locations but do not wish to be full members. Program Members do not have full facility privileges. Individual, Family and Family Plus Program Memberships are available. (See the above for membership descriptions)



APPLICATION FOR CREDIT STATEMENT

The Great Miami Valley YMCA association follows the YMCA of the USA policy on credits and refunds. The credit/ refund policy as approved by the Board of Trustees of the Great Miami Valley YMCA is as follows:



REFUNDS

Membership Refunds

Memberships are NON-REFUNDABLE.

Program Refunds

Refunds will be issued if the YMCA cancels a program. If a credit statement is turned in prior to the first week of classes, 100% of the amount paid (less \$2.00 administration fee) will be issued. You will be issued a check for the amount or you may request a credit, which can be used for any other expense incurred at the YMCA.

Registration Refunds

Registration fees are non-refundable.

Program Credits

Program credits will be issued ONLY under the following circumstances:

1. If the request is submitted prior to the first week of classes, 100% of the amount paid (less a \$2.00 administration fee) will be issued in the form of an online credit to be used at your convenience.
2. If the request is submitted during the second week of classes, 50% of the amount paid (less a \$2.00 administration fee) will be issued in the form of an online credit to be used at your convenience.
3. No credit will be given if the request is submitted after the second week of classes.

FACILITY USE GUIDELINES

The following rules are designed to assure the safety of all members:

- Members under the age of 10 are required to be under the supervision of a parent or guardian while in the YMCA buildings or grounds unless registered and participating in a YMCA program activity.
- Certain areas of the YMCA facility are restricted to use by specific age groups or restricted by specific supervision guidelines. Please check with your YMCA for details.
- Members must be 15 or over to participate at the Hamilton Central YMCA. Hours of operation vary from branch to branch and may change without prior notice. Always check with your branch for details. We make every effort to give advance notice when we must change our hours of operation.

GUEST PRIVILEGES

The YMCA is a membership organization with facilities and equipment provided for use by members, with certain activities available for an additional fee.

Guests must be accompanied by a member at all times. Members are limited to 3 guests per member or two families per member. Guests may participate in Group Exercise classes if space permits. We reserve the right to limit or restrict guest passes based on the needs of our business.

Additional restrictions may apply to the water park at East Butler County. See your branch for specific guest policy. Fees paid for passes may be applied to annual membership if application is made within 30 days and the receipts are produced.

Due to high facility utilization, specific branches may limit guest hours.

TRANSFERRING MEMBERSHIPS

Members who transfer from another YMCA will receive a credit for joining fees paid at their previous YMCA for a new membership at our YMCA. A letter is required from your previous YMCA to validate your membership.

MEMBER STATUS CHANGES

Changes to your membership, including additions or deletions of individuals from your membership or name and address changes, need to be processed in writing at the Welcome Center.

CLASS REGISTRATION

Full Members and Program Members may register for programs during specific dates indicated in the Program Guide and online. All fees must be paid at the time of registration. Members will be required to register for all programs, even those with no fee.

MEMBERSHIP CARDS:

Your Passport

Your YMCA membership card is a passport. Cards are non-transferable and remain property of the YMCA. You will be expected to present your membership card to the Welcome Center for scanning each time you enter the facility and when registering for programs. Lost cards may be replaced at your branch for a nominal fee.

YOUTH AND TEEN CENTERS

The Great Miami Valley YMCA gives young people a place to call their own. Our Youth and Teen Centers offer young people a safe and supervised environment, a place to socialize with friends, and a place to meet new friends. A place where caring, dedicated adults are there to listen to them and help them navigate the stresses, changes and choices that come with adolescence. It offers a place to build relationships where preteens and teens develop the inner strength to avoid destructive behavior. The Great Miami Valley YMCA Youth and Teen Centers use the core values of caring, honesty, respect, responsibility and faith to accomplish the vision of building strong kids, strong families and strong communities. Most branches have their own Youth and Teen Center that houses computer equipment, big screen TV, games and lounging areas.



YMCA FACILITIES CODE OF CONDUCT AND CHARACTER DEVELOPMENT

The YMCA believes building character is as important as building bodies, and the basis for character development includes five core values: Caring, Honesty, Respect, Responsibility, and Faith.

The YMCA focuses on the development of the spirit, mind and body of each individual, and plays a key role in character development through our programs and activities. We are committed to a positive approach to improving our community. When you enroll in one of the many great programs that the Great Miami Valley YMCA has to offer, you will notice the emphasis we place on building character through these five important attributes.

We promote safety and comfort for all and we ask individuals to act appropriately at all times when they are in our facility or participating in our programs.

Our Code of Conduct does not permit any language or action that can hurt or frighten another person, or that falls below a generally accepted standard of conduct. This includes:

- **Inappropriate attire** - appropriate attire must be worn at all times
- **Angry or vulgar language** - including swearing, name calling, or shouting
- **Physical contact with another person in any angry or threatening way**
- **Any demonstration of sexual activity or sexual contact** with another person
- **Harassment or intimidation** by words, gestures, body language or any other menacing behavior
- **Theft** or behavior that results in the **destruction of property**



- **Carrying or concealing any weapons** or devices or objects which may be used as weapons
- Using or possessing **illegal chemicals or alcohol** on YMCA property or in YMCA vehicles
- Any other **conduct of an inappropriate, threatening, or offensive nature**

If a member or guest feels uncomfortable in confronting the person directly, they should report the behavior to a staff person. Members and guests should not hesitate to notify a staff person if assistance is needed.

In order to carry out these policies, we ask that members and guests identify themselves when asked. The Executive Director or another senior staff person will investigate all reported incidents. Suspension or termination of YMCA membership privileges may result from a determination by the Executive Director if, in his/her discretion, a violation of the Code of Conduct has occurred.

Steps have been put in place to advise and assist in determining appropriate consequences for questionable behavior. Each case will be handled on an individual basis, and can result in a verbal warning to termination of membership.

PRIVACY POLICY

The policy of the Great Miami Valley YMCA is not to give information about its members, including whether a person is a member, to anyone without prior written consent of the member, except when compelled to give the information pursuant to a subpoena from a judicial or government body. The Great Miami Valley YMCA may disclose membership information to persons with whom it has contracts to perform functions for the YMCA, but only if the contracting party signs a confidentiality agreement agreeing not to disclose membership information.

HERITAGE CLUB

The YMCA Heritage Club emblem is a symbol of faith in the YMCA's future. It stands for the enlightened concern of individuals who have seen and felt the impact of the YMCA on the lives of so many young people. It is a reminder of the



YMCA's mission and a symbol of the desire to see the YMCA positively influence and serve its community.

The Heritage Club was established to provide supporters of the YMCA a way to ensure the long range financial stability of the organization. We do not ask for funds now but request that you consider including the YMCA in your long range financial plans. There are a variety of gift programs available for Heritage Club membership, including: outright gifts, bequests, charitable remainder trusts, gift annuities, gifts of life insurance, etc. There is no minimal amount to contribute to qualify for Heritage Club Membership.
